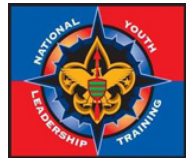

Personal Equipment Check List

Only BSA official uniforms are acceptable. Be prepared for an overnight hike as well as living in camp. Be prepared for all weather conditions by reviewing your Handbook, Field Book and the BSA on-line training and packing appropriately. Foot wear with covered toes is required.

Pack or duffel bag must be used for getting gear from the check-in to the campsite. Candidates must NOT use suitcases, footlockers, or trunks at the campsite. Patrol equipment including tents and cots will be issued.
