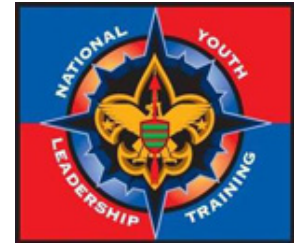

WHAT IS NYLT ?

The **National Youth Leadership Training** is a seven-day outdoor leadership experience for current and future leaders selected by you, the Scoutmaster or Crew Advisor. As the next generation and descendent of the legacy Junior Leader Training (JLT) course, NYLT is designed in coordination with **Wood Badge for the 21st Century**. The course provides the participant the experience to work as a member of a team, which they will also lead during the week. Participants receive classes, guidance and the experience to become a leader. The participants will write their own Vision Statement in which they will plan how to use their newly acquired skills in their home troops and crews.

WHAT IS ITS PURPOSE ?

The aims of the course are to give each participant a basic knowledge of various **modern leadership skills** while helping them relate these skills to their own troop and crew responsibilities; to give them the confidence and knowledge necessary to run their unit's program; to provide opportunities to share ideas and experiences and grow friendships with Scouts from other troops and Venturers from other Crews; and of course, to have **FUN!**

PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS:

AGE: 13 y/o by **Jan 1 of the year of the course** – Important, because the course requires a level of maturity.

RANK/TRAINING: Scouts must be First Class or higher. Venturers must have completed either the crew officer training or Venturing Leadership Skills Course.

Pre-Requisite – Participants **must** have attended **Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops (ILST) or Crews (ILSC)**.

EXPERIENCE: Scouts must have at least one long-term (week) camping experience. For Venturers, camping experience is recommended because the course is conducted in an outdoor camping setting.

Maturity, and the Scoutmaster's / Advisors recommendation.

SCOUTMASTER'S and ADVISOR'S RECOMMENDATION:

This is **very important!** You know your youth better than any one, and your thoughtful judgment is *vital* for our success and the successful experience for your Scout, your Venturer and each participant. Please understand the importance placed on your judgment regarding those youth wishing to participate. Keep in mind this is an intensive weeklong leadership training course, *not* summer camp.

Demonstrated maturity and ability to work with others are essential for this course!!!

WHERE: Quail Hill Scout Reservation

REGISTRATION: Registration forms and payment must be at council by June 15, 2020.

CAPACITY: The course is LIMITED to 48 participants. A waiting list will be maintained for those who register after the course is full.

Medical Forms must be submitted by June 15, 2020 **No registrations will be accepted after June 15.**
